

This summer, enjoy a scenic ride to the top of the mountain and back with your friends or family. Pacific Crest Chair provides great views of the Snoqualmie Pass area. Scenic lift ride tickets can be used for as many round-trip rides as you want on the date chosen, providing plenty of flexibility for travelers and visitors. At the top, unload the lift to enjoy the stunning views and take photos. To get down, you can either get back on the lift, or hike down the trail to the lodge.

Scenic chairlift rides operate Fridays from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sundays 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. through Labor Day weekend.

Ride into History

All aboard a living rail museum!

Washington State changed forever when the Northern Pacific Railroad reached Tacoma in 1883.

In a few short years, the rails led nearly everywhere, and the Snoqualmie Valley was no exception. The Northwest Railway Museum tells this story of settlement and development in the Snoqualmie Depot, aboard the train, and on the Museum campus on Stone Quarry Road. Climb aboard for both adventure and enlightenment.

The Northwest Railway Museum

has all the bells and whistles!

Incorporating more than five miles of Victorian-era railway and the 1890-built Snoqualmie Depot, the Museum is like no other: antique trains operate weekends from April 'til October and operate to transport visitors not to another place, but to another time. The exhibit galleries are open daily in the summer, and with reduced hours in the spring and fall. Yet no matter when you visit, there are a multitude of "train" ing opportunities!

For a different kind of experience that includes a beautiful country drive, start at Snoqualmie Falls and soak in the spectacular view. Then wander into the Salish Lodge and Spa and make sure to check out The Country Store for charming local artisan gifts and décor.

Continue along Hwy 202 to Fall City and stop by Aroma Coffee in the historic Prescott-Harshman House, which was built in 1904. After your cup is full, head to Carnation and pick up fresh pies from Remlinger Farms. Remlinger Farms has a variety of crafts and specialty food products made with love and a brand new brewery that you should check




Snoqualmie Tribe Ancestral Lands Movement

It is through education and awareness that individuals can integrate land acknowledgement and respect for the Snoqualmie Tribe into their recreational practices and experiences.



The Ancestral Lands Movement seeks to spread awareness of the Snoqualmie people who have lived in the southern Salish Sea region since time immemorial and share the significance of these lands and provide information on how people can help the Tribe in respecting, restoring, and protecting these lands.

Recreational Impacts on Tribal Lands

As the Salish Sea region has grown in population, the Snoqualmie Tribe's ancestral lands have been heavily impacted by recreation. This impact is especially apparent at the popular trails in the Snoqualmie corridor area, where increased visitation has resulted in a degradation of the land.

How You Can Help:

Here are simple steps everyone can take while recreating on Snoqualmie ancestral lands to practice respect and help the Tribe in protecting and restoring these lands for generations to come:

- Treat the lands with the respect they deserve, by picking up your own trash, and that of
 others that you see, properly disposing of pet waste, and staying on designated trails.
- Commit to experience the lands in a way that is <u>centered in mindfulness</u>, rather than conquest.
- Learn more about the Snoqualmie Tribe and its history and deep connection to these lands, and support the work the Tribe does today to continue stewarding these lands.
- Acknowledge that you are recreating on Snoqualmie ancestral lands through both written acknowledgement and through practice.
- Help the Tribe spread its message by encouraging others to learn more and practice land acknowledgement both on and off the trails.
