



ALL ABOARD A LIVING RAIL MUSEUM



The Northwest Railway Museum has all the bells and whistles!



Washington State changed forever when the Northern Pacific Railroad reached Tacoma in 1883. In a few short years, the rails led nearly everywhere, and the Snoqualmie Valley was no exception. The Northwest Railway Museum tells this story of settlement and development in the Snoqualmie Depot, aboard the train, and on the Museum campus on Stone Quarry Road. Climb aboard for both adventure and enlightenment.

Incorporating more than five miles of Victorian-era railway and the 1890-built Snoqualmie Depot, the Museum is like no other: antique trains operate weekends from April 'til October and operate to transport visitors not to another place, but to another time. The exhibit galleries are open daily in the summer, and with reduced hours in the spring and fall. Yet no matter when you visit, there are a multitude of "train"ing opportunities!

Fall City A RIVERSIDE COMMUNITY

Fall City is a family friendly, scenic Snoqualmie Valley unincorporated community located approximately 26 miles east of Seattle nestled along the banks of the Snoqualmie and Raging Rivers.

The rivers, trails and surrounding farms play a major role in drawing visitors to this area. In the summer and fall, fishing, floating or playing along the broad beautiful, gently sloping shoreline offer residents and visitors lots of recreational opportunities. Fall City, also, offers year-round access to the Preston-Fall City and Snoqualmie Valley trails for hikers, bikers and horseback riders. Valley farms and roadside stands supply fresh flowers and vegetables. In the fall visit the Pumpkin Patch for a walk into the fields to pick your own jack-o-lantern pumpkins for carving and sugar pumpkins for holiday pies.


Throughout the year Fall City Arts hosts a variety of family and fine arts programs, including "Shakespeare in the Park", a free, fun, annual summer tradition at Fall City Park. The Snoqualmie Falls Forest Theater's open air, rustic theater is a magical setting for theater goers young and old.

The Fall City Historical Society promotes and preserves the elements that make Fall City special including collecting, preserving and interpreting the history of Fall City as well as sharing our history through community programs, pop-up displays, brochures for your self-guided, historical walking tour through town, complete with historical plaques at most sites.

The Fall City Metropolitan Park District and King County Parks work hard to preserve and improve recreational opportunities for the current and future generations.

Every summer (Saturday, June 13), the Fall City Community Association hosts Fall City Day with a street parade, arts, crafts, food vendors, Ducky Derby, USATF certified and sanctioned fun run, and more. During the winter holiday season save time (Saturday, December 5, 2020) to shop the holiday market featuring the creations of the many area artist and crafts persons; then finish out your day at the evening tree lighting ceremony.

Come to Fall City for the day or an overnight stay at the historic Fall City Roadhouse or spend the night in a treehouse at Tree House Point, the home base of Treehouse Masters. Stroll around the town, hike or bike on the trails, shop in one or more of several second-hand/antique/consignment stores, take a self-guided historic and/or art walk, dine in one or more of our many eating establishments or pick up supplies from our farm fresh market for a picnic in the park or river side, and more.

Elk Viewing in the wild! Don't forget to bring your camera!

- Always observe from a distance, preferably downwind.
- Use binoculars or spotting scopes.
- Talk and move quietly; minimize sharp sounds.
- Early morning and twilight are ideal times to see animals; also check nearby fields for herds.
- Do not disturb animals in mating season, particularly bull elk in the fall rutting season.
- Never come between a mother and her offspring.
- If an animal becomes nervous or moves away, you are too close.
- Pets should stay home.





See Wild Elk!

In the Snoqualmie Valley!

Bring a camera! You can watch the upper Snoqualmie Valley's wild elk enjoy the open fields of Meadowbrook Farm Park from your car, or a paved, ADA accessible walking trail! This historic public open space is at the center of the 500-member elk herd's home range and offers multiple walking trails and car pull-outs for wildlife viewing.

While the elk may shelter in the trees during heavy rains, mornings and late afternoon or evenings are the best times to look for them, especially during summer and fall. Don't see an elk right away? Drive slowly around the perimeter of the Park—the elk may be in a nearby field. Walk quietly into one of the hidden fields. Visit the Snoqualmie Falls, sample the Valley's dining, breweries and shops, and look again for elk a bit later. Enjoy your visit to this unique public park!



Snovalley Schools HIGH QUALITY EDUCATION DELIVERED.



Welcome to the Snoqualmie Valley School District. Located in the scenic Cascade Mountain foothills, the district encompasses more than 400 square miles, serving families in Snoqualmie, North Bend, Fall City and surrounding areas of unincorporated King County. The district offers high quality education to approximately 7,200 students in 11 schools.

The district's mission is to prepare all students for college, career, and citizenship. With a focus on engaging and empowering all learners, Snoqualmie Valley schools offer rigorous academic curriculum, career education training, state-of-the-art technology resources, and project-based learning. Our district partners with professionals in the community to expose students to a variety of career experiences – helping them consider a wide range of options for the future, learn about relevant training or continuing education required for different careers, and realize their potential. Ultimately, our schools strive to prepare students for any path they may choose to pursue after high school.

Student achievement and the number of students choosing rigorous academic courses has trended upward in recent

years. The Class of 2018 graduation rate was 93.9% percent districtwide (95.8% percent at Mount Si High School). Snoqualmie Valley has been recognized for AP Honor Roll distinctions by the College Board, and Mount Si High School has been named on is among top high school bands in the nation, selected to perform at the Essentially Ellington Festival in New York five times, most recently in 2019.

Our school district is growing. (Enrollment has grown approximately 31% over the past ten years!) Thanks to the community's support of school bonds and levies, the district has been expanding school facilities and improving programs to serve our growing student population. Since 2016, for example, the district opened its 6th elementary school (Timber Ridge Elementary), and state-of-the-art security systems have been installed throughout all Snoqualmie Valley schools.

This fall marks an especially exciting time as our brand new, modernized and expanded Mount Si High School opened to serve Snoqualmie Valley students in grades 9-12! After years of planning and construction, students now benefit from ample space to learn and collaborate, outstanding technology resources throughout the facilities, new Career and Technical Education (CTE) course options, enhanced support for students with disabilities, and continued attention on ensuring successful freshmen transitions into high school. The campus was built on an elevated platform above groundlevel parking – a design which complies with floodway and parking requirements, has added fortification for earthquake resilience, and supports significant security and safety enhancements. Aesthetically, Mount Si High School features special design elements to honor the history of the Valley, with extensive natural lighting throughout the campus, and stunning views of the school's namesake and surrounding mountains.

Phase 2 of MSHS construction is continuing, and includes demolshing the old school, finishing new baseball and softball fields, preparing the sight to support a Performing Art Center, and adding bus lanes and parking.

Also starting this 2019-20 school year, Snoqualmie Middle School re-opened in place of the former freshman campus. This provided an opportunity to align best practices across all three SVSD middle schools, while alleviating crowding in grades 6-8. Two Rivers School transitioned to a "Big Picture" school this fall, offering a new educational program that centers around student-driven, real-world learning with worksite experience, community mentors and competencybased instruction for grades 9-12. And, the district is launching its One-to-one Computing Initiative this year. To ensure equitable access to resources for all students, every student in grades 6-12 will be given a laptop to use at school and at home, while enrolled in our district.

SVSD schools value a well-rounded education and offer a broad range of extracurricular experiences, to help students discover their passions for life-long learning. Staff work to create a positive and safe learning environment, where all students feel respected, valued, capable, loved and that they belong to a caring and nurturing organization. At all levels, staff are focusing on the social and emotional needs of students, working to support, engage and empower all learners!



Strong community support, coupled with the daily efforts of exceptional staff, make the Snoqualmie Valley School District a very special place for children to grow and learn.




Snoqualmie Point Park







Emergency Preparedness

Are You Ready for a Disaster? At any time, a disaster could strike and affect you and your family. From flooding to snowfall or from long term power outages to pandemic flu, we are all vulnerable, and we all should be prepared. **48% of Americans are not ready - are you?**



Earthquake

The Snoqualmie Valley and the Seattle Metropolitan area is prone to earthquakes. Many fault lines run through the region and can shift at any time. Do you know what to do if an earthquake strikes? First, protect yourself from injury. If driving, pull your car to the side of the road until the shaking stops. If you are outside, stay away from buildings. If you are inside, drop – cover – and hold on:

If you are in bed, lay face down and cover your head and neck with a pillow. Do not run outside, and do not stand in a doorway. For more on earthquake safety, go to **ready.gov/earthquakes** Earthquakes happen almost every day in Washington State, although most are not large enough to realize. Large earthquakes are rare but are likely to happen in your lifetime. Being prepared BEFORE the quake happens is very important. Here are a few things you can do now to better prepare yourself if an earthquake happens in your community:

- Prepare to be without electricity, water, natural gas, phones, gas for your vehicles, or access to internet (Grocery stores may be without power or closed for an extended period).
- Be prepared for at least five days on your own.
- Make an emergency response plan for your family.
- Know hazards around you. For example, earthquakes can trigger landslides.
- Participate in the yearly "Great Shake Out" drills.

When an earthquake does happen, you need to know what to do. Drop to your hands and knees, cover your head and hold on. Stay covered and protected until after the shaking stops. Keep far away from anything that can fall on you or break and cause injuries. It is very important that you practice these steps above, so you know what to do if an earthquake happens.

Winter Safety Tips

The Snoqualmie Valley and Seattle metropolitan region have been hit with some significant winter events. In 2019, three-feet of snow fell in the North Bend, WA area confining people to their homes for multiple days. Do you know what to do if a winter storm hits the region? The following are some recommendations on how to be prepared for a winter storm. First, stay off the roads. Driving on unplowed roads can be slippery or cause you to get stuck. Once stuck, plows and other emergency vehicles may not be able to pass. It is best to stay put in your warm house. You should also be prepared for power outages. Limbs with heavy snow may break and cause power outages.

The Puget Sound Energy (PSE) outage map: **pse.com/outage/outage-map** can be beneficial in learning where power is out and for how long. If you have a generator, make sure it is run outside away from the house, as this will prevent accidental carbon monoxide poisoning.

Drowning Prevention

Drowning is a preventable tragedy and an important public health and safety issue. Warm weather draws people to lakes, rivers and saltwater areas. This creates high risk situations for the individual, others, and rescuers. Swimmers, boaters, and other water recreationists should follow these recommendations to prevent drownings:

- **Know the risks** Rivers are cold and the water moves fast. Waters are often cold enough to cause muscles to cease and cramp, even on the hottest summer day. Cold water can weaken even the strongest swimmer.
- Learn to swim, including water safety and survival skills -To enjoy the water safely, learn swim strokes, water safety, survival skills, and become comfortable in the water.
- Wear a lifejacket Always wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejacket when boating, tubing, paddle boarding, rafting, swimming or when participating in other activities in or on the water.
- Swim where there is a lifeguard Swim in areas with lifeguards when possible.
- Supervise children in or near water Always provide close and constant attention to children you are supervising in or near water.
- Do not use alcohol or drugs during water activities -Never use alcohol or other impairing drugs during water and boating activities, or while supervising children around the water.
- Learn first aid and CPR Eastside Fire & Rescue provides public CPR/First Aid training. Register today at Eastsidefire-rescue.org.



Eastside Fire & Rescue and Local 2878 Benevolent Fund have personal floatation device (PFD) loaner stations at several locations in the community.

There are three life jacket loaner stations located at Lake Sam-

mamish State Park, one station at Rattlesnake Lake, and two stations in Fall City on the Snoqualmie River. The program is funded

by: Seattle Children's Hospital, King County Drowning Prevention Network, Paris White Foundation, and Eastside Firefighters Benevolent Fund.



Wildfire

Wildfires are becoming a popular topic in western Washington. This threat is increasing, and residents should be aware of how to protect themselves from fire. The following are some tips on how to protect your house against wildfire. First, create a green space around your property. Grass and other less green-trees slow the spread of fire. It is also essential to keep your gutter and roof clear of dried debris. It can catch fire and put your home at risk. Remove dead and dry materials from around your yard. And, limbup dry trees approximately six to ten feet up from the ground. This will prevent ground fires from burning up a tree and starting a massive wildfire.
